Finding Courage in the Quiet Presence of God

Fear has a quiet way of making life smaller. It can keep us from speaking the truth, having a needed conversation, or taking the next step God is asking of us. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus speaks directly to that fear: "Do not be afraid." He does not promise His disciples an easy path, but He reminds them they are known, loved, and never forgotten by the Father.

Jeremiah discovered the same truth. Surrounded by opposition, he still proclaimed, "The Lord is with me, like a mighty champion." His courage came not from his circumstances, but from God's presence.

The Little Way is not the absence of fear, but trust in the midst of it. This week, place one fear before the Lord and take one small step forward in faith. Jesus is already there.
