Faith Formation classes will begin on Sunday September 13th at 9:15 am in the gym. We will hold a parent meeting during that time as well.

Registration is open to all children Kindergarten – 6th grade in the parish.

* (Classes can also be adapted for those who fall out of the typical grade range (7th-12th).

Cost - \$30 per child not to exceed \$100.

Please Note: Children participating in Faith Formation typically receive 2 years of sacramental preparation for First Holy Communion and Confirmation. First Communion's first year of preparation begins in First grade with reception of the Sacrament in 2nd grade. Confirmation's first year of sacramental prep begins in 5th grade with the reception of the sacrament in 6th grade.

*FF program can be adapted to children who fall outside the typical sacramental preparation years as well. Please reach out to Charlotte in the office with any questions or concerns.
