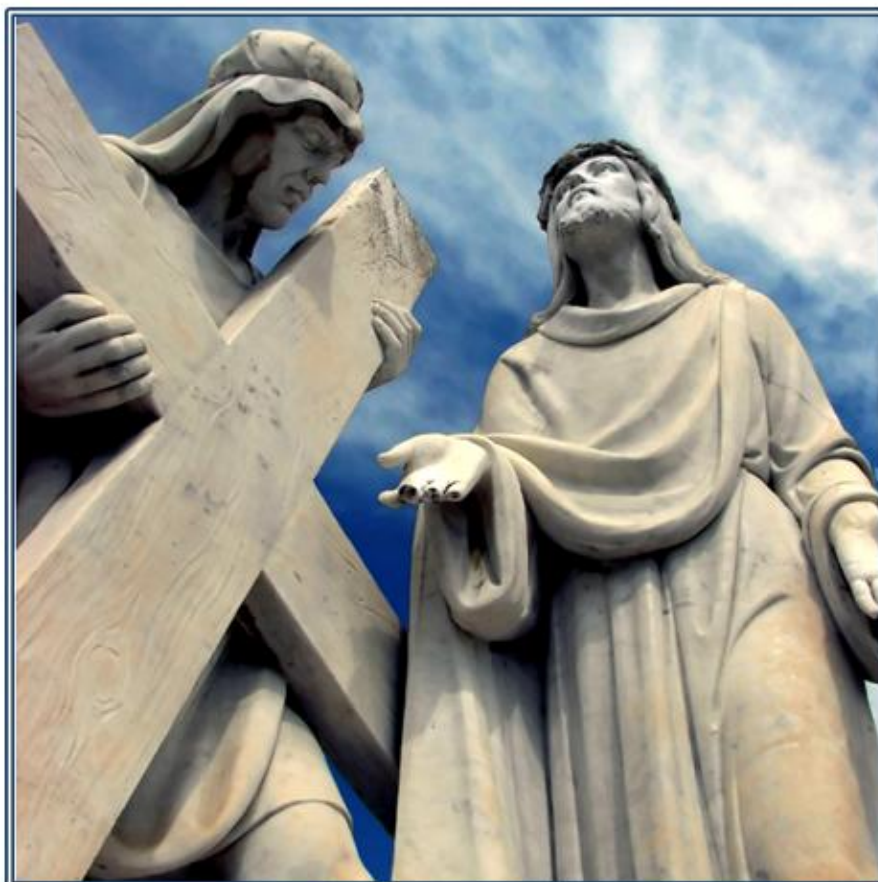

Faith Formation is gearing up to return in just a few short weeks! Please take advantage of early registration and register your children online using the provided QR code.
