That rest is not an escape. It is Christ drawing near to people who are tired, afraid, and carrying more than they can hold alone.

As Missionary Disciples, our response must be both prayer and action. We pray for rain, protection, firefighters, first responders, and all affected by the fires. And we act: checking on neighbors, supporting the displaced, sharing resources, and remembering especially the poor, the elderly, and the vulnerable.

This is the Little Way in a fire season. Remember we are people of hope: one prayer, one act of charity, one small surrender to God. And so, come to Him, then help carry another's burden.
