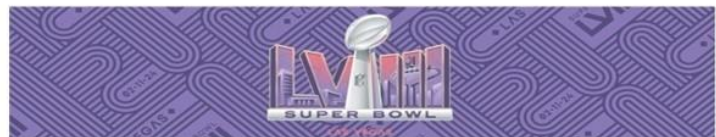

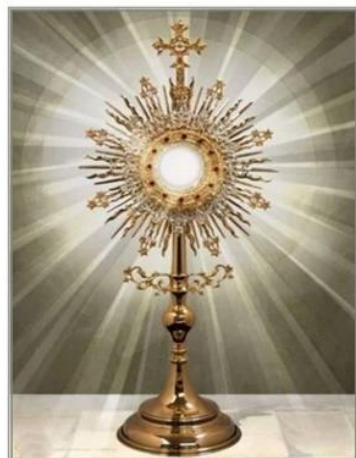

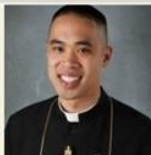


Memorial of St. Scholastica February 10
