

#### The Shroud of Turin

The Shroud of Turin is the most scientifically researched artifact in history. Many believe it to be the original burial cloth of Jesus Christ. Others believe it to be a fourteenth century forgery. Facilitators will summarize the historical background of the Shroud, and details of the prominent data/evidence collected, and the conclusions of scientific experts regarding what is known and unknown from the peer-reviewed scientific data. Facilitators will create time for group reflection and discussion regarding the science of the Shroud, and its relevance, or lack thereof, to our faith in Jesus Christ and His Resurrection.
