**Westcliffe – 2 - 3:30 in front of Custer County School**

On the first Sunday of every October since 1987, peaceful people have gathered on the sidewalks in hundreds of communities in the United States and Canada to take a public stand and pray to end abortion. In Pueblo, the first Life Chain was in 1992! This year, the pro-life people will be there again and signs will be provided.

**Will you be counted among them?**

**LIFE CHAIN** is a **peaceful** and **prayerful** public witness of pro-life individuals standing for 90 minutes (or as long as you are able) praying **for our nation** and **for an end to abortion**. It is a visual statement of **solidarity** by the Christian community that **abortion kills children** and that the Church supports **the sanctity of human life** from the moment of conception until natural death.

**We never know who will view**

**and be changed by our sidewalk ministry.**

**But God Knows!**

He knows each driver, each passenger, and each pedestrian who passes our way. He knows them by their names. He knows them by their hearts. He knows them by their needs. We build our Chains for

Him to work through as He purposes, to reach whomever He chooses. We serve Life because we care, and in most instances the consequences of our caring remain unknown to us.

**Little Flower Book Club**

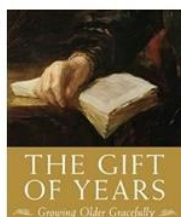
Want to look at your spirituality in the latter part of your life? Join us for reading
