

Thanksgiving Reflection

Though I can't identify any specific moment of insight, our Lord helped me see that before he handed the chalice of his Blood to his disciples, he first gave thanks. He, who was about to suffer horrifically and die for us, made his work of salvation an act of thanksgiving to the Father! This act of thanksgiving begins—must necessarily begin—with the thanksgiving of Jesus, our head. The best way to give thanks to the Father is to join our thanksgiving to the perfect act of thanksgiving by the Son in the Eucharist.

This Thanksgiving Day is a golden opportunity for us as Catholics to witness not only to the need for giving the Father thanks for his bountiful gifts and mercy, but also to unite ourselves with the greatest act of thanksgiving we can make as a Church.
