LOUIS AND ZELIE MARTIN SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Shrine of St. Therese will be offering scholarships to the **St. Therese Catholic School (STCS)**. If you have children registered for the 2022-2023 academic year at STCS; and you meet the below listed criteria, you are invited to submit an application (*please see reverse side*). All applications must be received at the parish office on or before August 8, 2022 by 3:00 pm. To be considered for these funds you must meet the following criteria:

- ❖ Your family must attend Mass regularly at the Shrine of St. Therese and be known by the pastor.
- ❖ Parents must be involved in some form of volunteer ministry within the parish.
- ❖ Parents will need to have made monetary contributions to The Shrine of St. Therese parish offertory collection during the previous year that amounts to a minimum of \$100.00.
- ❖ Your family must be registered at the Shrine of St. Therese parish for 12 months prior to the date of application (*at the pastor's discretion*).

How are these Scholarships funded?

Parishioners who receive donation envelopes from the Shrine of St. Therese have in their monthly packets a special "blue" envelope labeled, *Louis and Zelie Martin Scholarship Fund*. They in turn send donations, throughout the year, and the parish collects this money so that it may be awarded the following year. 2022-2023 scholarships are awarded from the funds collected in 2021-2022.
