

Then, beginning at 12:30pm we invite you to join our Shrine parishioners for BINGO from 12:30pm to 3pm in the gym.


We will begin a progressive game on September 28th, with more opportunities in October, November and December. 50/50 raffle and pull tabs will also be available.


2025-2026 Faith Format Registration



Prayer for Catechists


oving Father, we pray today for our catechists. We thank you for their gift of ministry in your Church.
