Shrine Faith Formation Department Information



-Faith Formation registration will be open beginning the weekend of August 13th/14th. If you are a parishioner at the Shrine and have a child in kindergarten thru 6th grade who would like to attend Faith Formation, please take advantage of early registration.

-Please note the Shrine's Sacramental Faith Formation programs, with exception of the OCIC program, are two-year programs. Meaning children who are wanting to receive the Sacrament of First Holy Eucharist or Confirmation should have two years of preparation before receiving the Sacrament. After two years of preparation a readiness interview with the pastor will be conducted to determine the child's readiness to receive the Sacrament.

The Sacrament of First Holy Eucharist is typically received in 2nd grade after their first year of preparation in 1st grade is completed.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is typically received in 6th grade following their first year of prep in 5th grade.

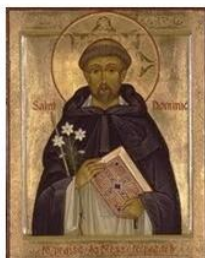
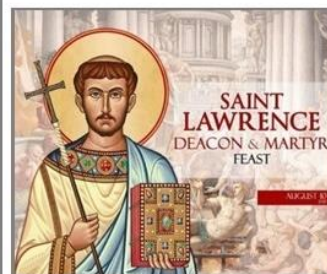
-Faith Formation will begin Sunday Sept. 8th with a parent meeting @ 9:15 am in the parish hall/gym.

Sunday September 15th classes for all grades will resume at 9:15am.

When the Roman authorities captured and killed Pope Sixtus II and the other six deacons, St. Lawrence was left to administer what remained. He was taken prisoner and told to collect the "treasures of the Church." Instead of gold and silver, he presented the poor people to whom he had distributed the chalices, patens, and other altar vessels. Angered, it is said that the Roman prefect tortured Lawrence by chaining him to a gridiron and roasting him upon it. After the martyr had suffered the pain for a long time, the tradition states he made his famous remark, "It is well done. Turn me over!"

May God the Son, who redeemed us, send healing into our midst.

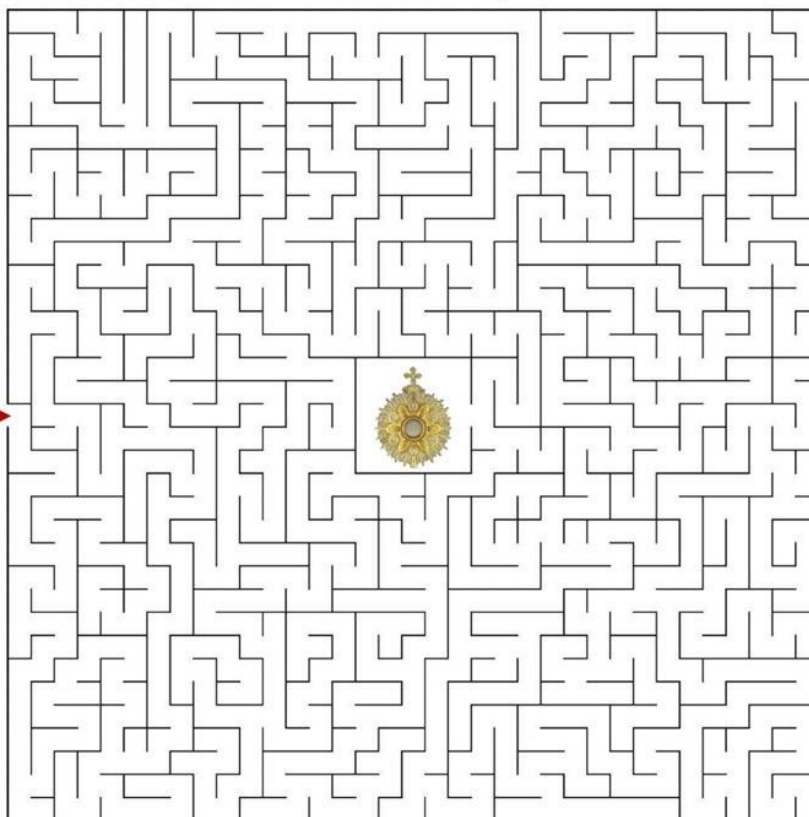
May God the Holy Spirit, who gives us life, move within us.

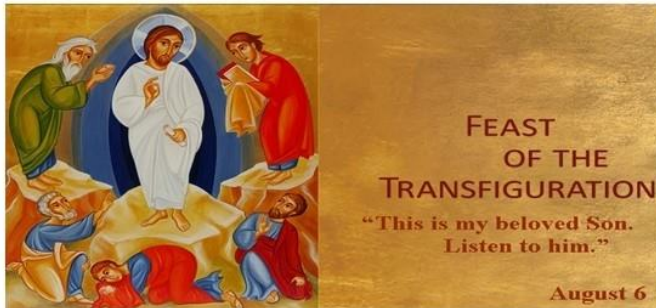



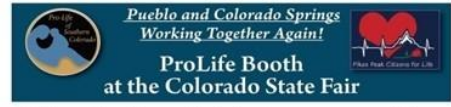
