

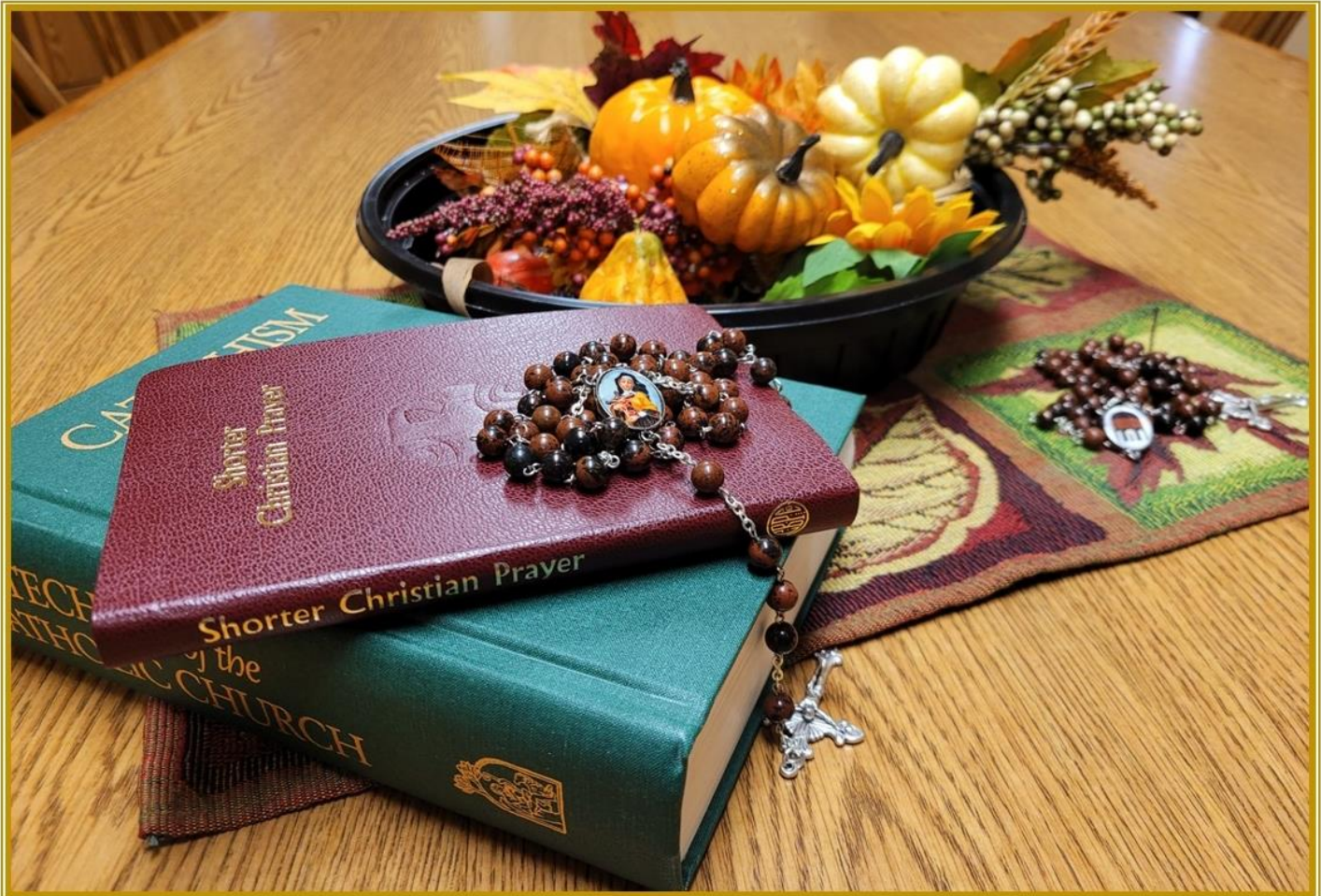

KING SOOPERS REWARDS PROGRAM



This is a great way to support Shrine of St. Therese Parish

Just by using your King Soopers Loyalty Card!

King Soopers has changed their rewards program so that anyone with a King Soopers loyalty card can earn rewards for the Shrine of St. Therese by swiping your card or entering your phone number at checkout. There will no longer be a need to purchase gift cards and we will no longer sell the reloadable cards for King Soopers.

(Safeway/Albertsons and WalMart cards will still be available).

After you register your King Soopers card, a percentage of all your purchases will support Shrine of St. Therese!!!!

To begin earning rewards, please take a few minutes to complete the following steps:

1. Visit <https://www.kingsoopers.com>
2. Go to the right side of the screen and click where it says "Welcome, Sign In." Create King Soopers account with a valid email if you don't have one already. If you do, just login. If you don't have a loyalty card, they are available at the store's customer service desk.
3. Once logged in, click on "My Account" on the right side. Then click on "Community Rewards" on the left side of the screen.
4. This will take you to a screen where you can enter the Organization Number: **"JR838"** or search for the Organization Name: **"Shrine of St. Therese Parish"** 300 Goodnight Avenue, Pueblo CO 81004
5. Click on the button to enroll.
6. This should take you to a screen that says you have successfully enrolled.
7. Shop at King Soopers using your enrolled King Soopers Loyalty Card.
