Youth in and around our parish have decided to extend their summer supply drive for the homeless into the next Season: Fall. They will be collecting the following four foods:

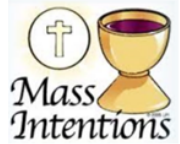
Uncrustables sandwiches Soft granola bars

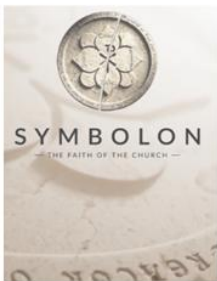
