

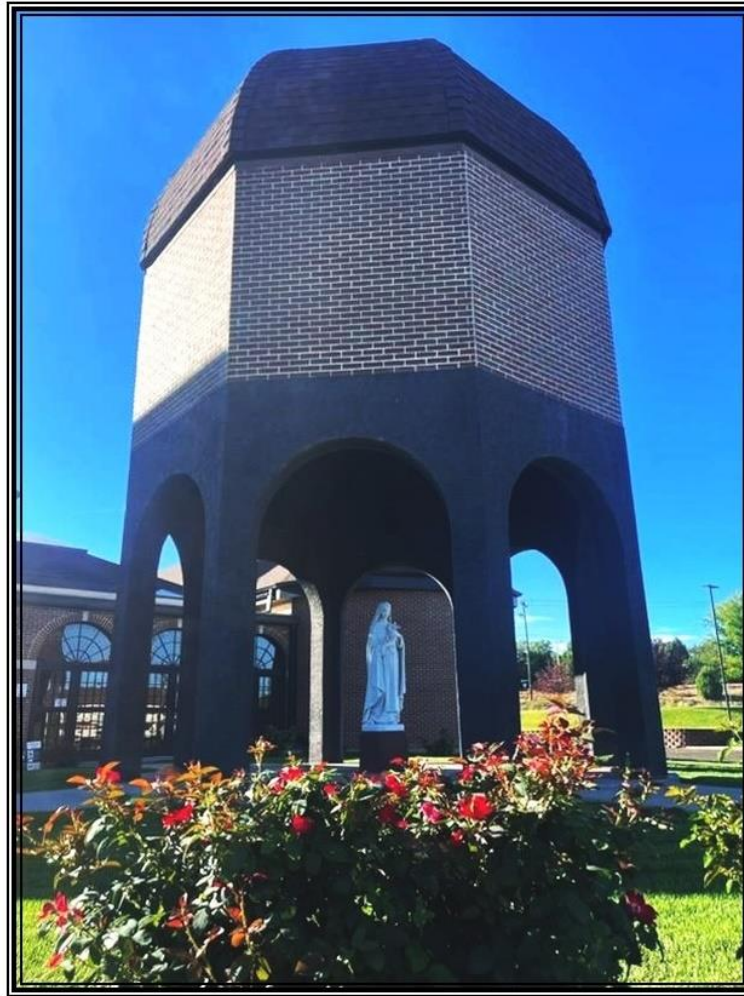

**What is OCIA?**

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) is the process for adults who desire to join the Catholic faith and for those seeking more information on the Catholic Church. OCIA can also be a method for Catholics to complete their reception of the initiation sacraments. The rite is designed for adults “who after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God”.

**Who is OCIA for?**

- ◆ Non-Catholics who want to find out more about the Catholic Faith
- ◆ Those who want to join the Catholic Church through Baptism, or Profession of Faith
- ◆ Those who were baptized Catholic as infants but never received religious education, Confirmation, or First Eucharist.
