Caregivers provide care to people who need some degree of ongoing assistance with everyday tasks on a regular or daily basis. Caregivers help with a variety of routine tasks such as shopping, paying bills, bathing, dressing, and managing medicines. They are often a source of emotional support and companionship for care recipients. The recipients of care can range from children to older adults, and may have chronic illnesses or disabling conditions.

If you are a friend or relative of someone who is a caregiver, you may wonder how you can provide emotional support. Here are a few ideas that may be beneficial for your loved one:

- **Provide respite care.** We all need a break now and then to refresh and recharge, especially during stressful situations. Offering to take over caregiving duties for a few hours for your family member or friend can go a long way towards helping to alleviate their stress.

Give them the opportunity to visit Eucharistic Adoration.

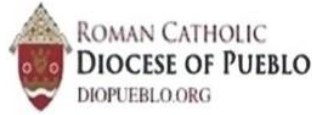
- **Lend an ear.** Check in regularly with your family member or friend. Give them a call and let them vent if needed. Let them know that you are always there for them whenever they need to talk.
- **Take them for a day out.** Spending a day with friends can do wonders for anyone's emotional health. Take them out to lunch or shopping, or spend the day at a museum or seeing a play. This gives your loved one both something to look forward to and a day of fun and socializing. If necessary, hire a home health care agency to provide respite during your day out or locate a medical adult day center.
- **Run errands or help with chores.** Help take things off the caregiver's to-do list. Offer to pick up groceries for them or vacuum. This can help them feel a little less overwhelmed with all of the day-to-day things they need to take care of.
- **Keep them in your prayers, or offer to pray with them.**

What you will be doing

The Payroll & Benefits Administrator will oversee the maintenance of employee benefits files, maintains group benefits databases, manages payroll, and updates employee payroll records. Specifically, the timely and accurate delivery of payroll and maintenance of benefit programs for all entities in the Diocese of Pueblo, such as payroll and benefit account maintenance, vacation, sick time accruals, reconciliations, and reports. Responsibilities include gathering employee data and overseeing the processing of monthly billings and the preparation of vouchers for payment of administrative fees for all group plans.

This position also resolves employees' issues and concerns to the company's proper channels. and helps in the audit of the company and ensures compliance with state and federal regulations. This requires a strong knowledge of payroll compliance and legislation and general accounting principles and procedures.
