Eligibility Requirements:

1. Be a full, active participating member of a parish in the Diocese of Pueblo.
2. Indicate you will be a full-time certificate/degree seeking student at an accredited community college, college, or university during the award period.
3. Complete the DCCW College Scholarship application package.
4. Provide three letters of recommendation: Two letters from someone familiar with academic performance and/or character of the applicant (neither letter should be from a relative) and one letter from your parish Pastor or pastoral staff member who is familiar with applicant.

Deadline for application is April 20, 2024. Award notification will be prior to the end of the current school year. Your high school will be notified of your award. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
